1. Website

- We can have a subscription system for members

- We can switch from annual dues to automatic renewals
- An outside email program, like MailChimp, is the easiest way to go for email
- Wordpress is simple and inexpensive – \$30 – 100 a year
- We want a people search. CodaWorx has a nice search function
- Drop down boxes are nice – clean & simple – fewer words on the page
