Treasurers Report - Robert - End of April \$18,437.76 deposits totaled \$1163,85, largely from registrations received for the ACLS Summer Retreat. One expense of FTM for \$104.07 We are looking into what to do with advertising for later this year.

Membership - report postponed

Minutes - Meeting moved to May 17th, not the 24th as shown in the minutes. Robert motioned to approve, Jim 2nd

Webinar - Paul - the last two meetings have been focused on ideas for next year. About half are defined and in place for 2019. A panel discussion for Liturgical consulting may be a good format to help new members help understand the role of a LDC.

Newsletter - Shelley - perhaps at the retreat we can recruit people to provide news?!

Communications - Jim - Sent a proposed revision to the use of Terms - see his email - Robert made a motion to approve and it passed with consensus. Will should make the changes on the website. Shelley will add this to the next newsletter.

Retreat - Paul - Carol meeting with John tomorrow. It is being organized around four figures and a musician and how they can help us in our personal and work life. A meeting location for Monday night is being worked on as well as planning for transportation. Only 9 of the 15 have responded regarding food. Snacks - 4 breaks - the Ridge will set up these outside the room. We will have access to a screen and projector. There are also 3 70" displays included. The dinner is in a private dining area connected to the restaurant. All the blocks of rooms are booked but we cannot increase the number of rooms- the hotel is full. Robert will contact Gianfranco regarding his question about coming for only one day. The board feels that wouldn't be a good idea.

Website - Robert - Newberry recommended we update the look of the website using different templates that are available. The banking account is a minimum of \$1500 which gives us more room to use money for this and not go under the minimum. This may be a good discussion at the retreat.
